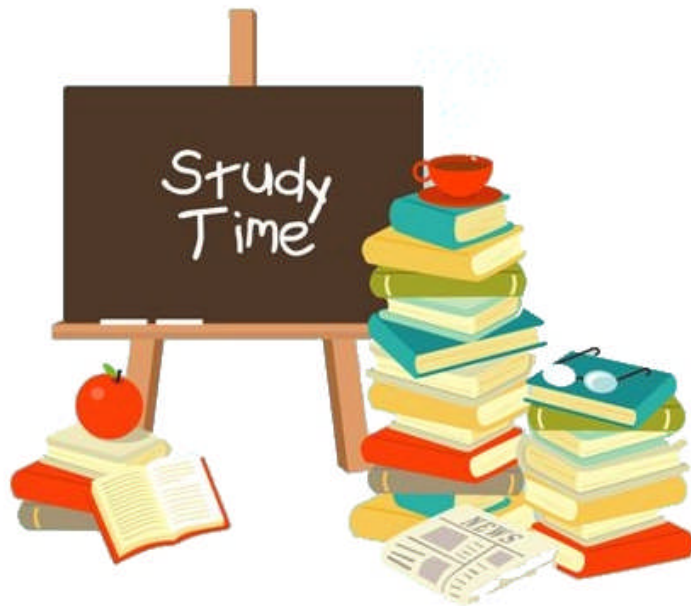

**Description:** Yoga is a great way to learn some strategies to regain focus, reduce stress and anxiety in the classroom and to get to know our bodies better. We will be playing with some breathing exercises and postures that will help us to become more aware of our breath and body. Each week your child will learn a new strategy that they can practice right in their seat during class. This yoga class is open to all students. If there is high demand, I will separate classes into a lower school and upper school class. You will need to wear clothes you can move in and bring a beach sized towel or yoga mat if you have one.

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

**Q. What dates does Third Quarter Learning Lab cover?**

A. Third Quarter Lab begins Monday, January 30th and ends Friday, March 30th.



**Q. What happens if one of my scheduled classes or tutoring dates falls on a holiday?**

A. All holidays during this quarter have already been factored into the fee schedule this quarter.

**Q. Where does my lower school child go while waiting for class to begin at 3:30pm?**

A. Lower school children should go to after school care until class begins.

**Q. The brochure says that there is a minimum class size for some classes. What happens if enough students do not sign up for a class?**

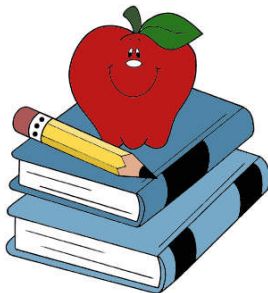
A. The class will be cancelled and you will have the opportunity to sign up for a different class if you choose to.

**Q. Can students drop out of the class/service and get a refund if they decide they do not like the class?**

A. A pro-rated refund will be given during the first week of the class NO REFUNDS shall be issued after the beginning of the second class of any program and refunds will not be made for missed sessions unless cancelled by the instructor.

## Tips for Helping with Homework

- Show an interest in your child's homework. Inquire about the subjects and the work to be done. Ask questions that require answers longer than one or two words.
- Help your child organize homework materials before beginning.
- Establish a regular time with your child to do homework; developing a schedule helps avoid procrastination.
- Find a specific place for your child to do homework that has lots of light, quiet, and plenty of work space.
- Encourage your child to ask questions and search for answers, taking the time to figure out correct answers.
- Make sure your child backs up answers with facts and evidence.
- Practice school-taught skills at home.
- Relate homework to your child's everyday life. For instance, teach fractions and measurements as you prepare a favorite food together.
- Be a role model-take the opportunity to read a book or news-paper or write a letter while your child studies.
- Praise your child for both the small steps and big leaps in the right direction.

Parents pay a set fee for the entire quarter (just like tuition). Tutoring is charged by the hour at \$95/hour. If tutors are absent, tutors will work with parents to reschedule the missed service.
