



# CAS Summer Program

The CAS summer program is designed for students entering grades 1-7 who possess average to above average intelligence, a history of healthy emotional development, and have been diagnosed with a language-based learning difference or recommended by a current teacher. The program offers intensive academic skill development and remediation in both language arts and math. Our program includes both whole group and small group instruction, with a 1:6 student-teacher ratio. Our program is taught using multisensory methodologies which infuse visual, auditory and kinesthetic channels in order to reinforce concepts and enable all students to learn. CAS also offers an afternoon summer camp from 12:30 to 4:30pm that encompasses fun, confidence-building activities.

The language programs in grades 1-4 are based on the Wilson Foundation program, and in grades 5-7 the Language! program. CAS teachers incorporate multisensory strategies and methodologies to enhance the literacy program and ensure our students are learning the necessary skills.

The math programs in grades 1-5 are based on the Scott Foresman Math program, in grades 6-7 the AGS program, and again are taught using multisensory strategies and methodologies. Each room has two teachers to accommodate small learning groups.
